Scholarship Requirements

Private study is a very important means to becoming musically proficient. The Lamar High School Choir program is committed to providing scholarship opportunities for students enrolled in the Arlington Music Enrichment Program. These scholarships are designed to encourage students who might not have the opportunity to study music privately otherwise. Scholarships are intended for students who have indicated a sincere desire to become better musicians and contribute their talents to the strengthening of their own musical organization.

Students must meet all the requirements listed below in order to qualify for these scholarships.

- Students must be enrolled in Lamar High School Choir program.
- Students must submit a completed Scholarship Application form to the campus director.
- Scholarships awarded may be used for study only in the Arlington Music Enrichment Program.
- Students must remain **academically eligible** in order to retain the scholarship privilege.
- Scholarships will be awarded based on need and merit.
- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the instructor.
- Students who are awarded a scholarship must **complete six (6) hours of volunteer work for the campus director before March 5, 2019.**
- Students must **submit a written log of hours, signed by a choir or voice faculty member, before March 5, 2019.**

Failure to maintain the above requirements will result in **immediate withdrawal of scholarship funds.**

Scholarship Award Letters will be mailed prior to the student's first lesson of the 2018-2019 Arlington ISD school year. Scholarship awards will terminate at the conclusion of each school year.
